Schedule "A"

DECLARATION

We, the undersigned, hereby declare that we desire to form a Society under the Societies Act and that:

1. The name of the Society is *The Nanaimo Curling Club*.
2. The objects of which the Society is formed are:
 - a. To organize the promotion of curling or other winter sports and associated winter activities.
 - b. To promote the mental, moral, physical and social well being of its members and to provide ways and means of raising funds for the purpose of carrying out these objects and in particular for the raising of funds for the purpose of club buildings and equipment with facilities for the necessary ice surfaces.
 - c. To cooperate with other Societies or other organizations whose aims are similar to the objects of this Society.
 - d. To promote or assist in promotion of any movement having for its objects the well-being of the community in the City of Nanaimo, and vicinity.
3. The operations of the Society are to be chiefly carried on in the City of Nanaimo, British Columbia, and the immediate vicinity.
4. **Dissolution Clause.**

In the event of the winding-up or dissolution of the Society, all of the funds and assets of the Society remaining after the payment or satisfaction of all costs, charges, expenses, debts and liabilities of the Society, including the remuneration (if any) of a liquidator, and after payment to employees of the Society of any arrears of salaries or wages, and after the payment of any debts of the Society, shall be given, transferred and distributed to such organizations that are registered charities pursuant to the provisions of the Income Tax Act that shall be designated by the members of the Society at the time of the winding-up or dissolution of the Society, and if effected cannot be given to the afore-said provisions, such funds shall be given, transferred and distributed to such organizations that are determined by the members of the Society to be registered charities pursuant to the provisions of the Income Tax Act which have purposes similar to those of the Society.

This Dissolution Clause shall remain unalterable until the

winding-up or dissolution of the Society.
